BMMA-SEHR

- Monthly meetings were conducted with the girls in Khatikwadi, Behrampada and Navpada.
 - 10 girls who attended the meeting in February in Khatikwadi are studying further through correspondence.
 - The movie Armaan was screened during the September meeting.
 - In the month of May, the girls held 2 independent meetings to plan independent activities.
 - A meeting for all the leaders was conducted in January.
- Visits to Pipeline, Gyaneshwar Nagar to meet the girl's group in January.
- 2 meetings were held with parents of Sehr group to motivate their daughters to join the group. The meetings were held in Navpada and Bharatnagar in the month of November.
- The Human Dignity Foundation(HDF) planning and review meeting was attended by Aliya, Suraiya Shaikh, Dr. Noorjahan Safia Niaz, Khatoon Shaikh & Neetu Singh in November.
- A total of 106 intake forms were filled from Navpada, Bharat Nagar, Bhairam and Pipeline.
- Homes of 12 girls were visited in March to find out the reason for their absence.
- 10 people between the age group of 18-25 years took up BMMA membership in November.
- A new group of 12 girls was formed at Bharat Nagar in June.
- Ms. Nayna from All India Local Self Government took a session on vocational training and placement for jobs in January.
- Training on leadership was conducted in January for the girls.
- Visit to MAVIM in January as an exposure visit.
- Meeting with Pratham for coordination and with MAVA for Girls Film Festival in January.
- The Traffic Head Office was visited in January.
- 5 girls were enrolled in the Civil Defence course in January.
- 12 girls participated in a dharna at the Dadar railway station in January.
- 16 girls attended the Gas morcha in February
- 20 girls visited the Traffic Controller office at Churchgate in February.
- 7 girls participated in the dance programme for Women's day celebrations in March.
- The girls attended a full day workshop on 'Dreams and Aspirations' in May. In the workshop the girls were encouraged to think about their future and have a vision for themselves. Another workshop was held for girls to know about themselves. The focus of this session was to know more about the different aspects of their personality; the mind and the body.

- 3 theatre workshops were held in collaboration with Kabeera Group in the month of May.
- The girls attended the open MIC session for public speaking practice in May.
- 2 girls from Sehr group attended the Mohalla Movement Trust meeting at National Girls High School in June.
- 6 girls visited the H ward Corporator in June with regard to cleanliness due to which garbage collection work has been started.
- Information regarding the Nursing training course by Mahila Vikas Kendra for girls and women over 18 years of age with a minimum qualification of Standard 8 passed was passed on to the Sehr group of Bharat Nagar and Navpada in June.
- 3 girls assisted in the cricket tournament and CM collection in June.
- The Sehr group attended a session on Short Film Making at Worli in July.
- 2 meetings were conducted in August on the issue of unpaid care work which were attended by 15 and 10 girls respectively.
- 4 girls attended a training session on communication skills and personality development in August.
- In September all Sehr group members went to the movie theatre & watched Mardani.
- 4 girls took part in the Safety walk in Navpada, Pipeline bridge & sky walk in September and the Navpada & pipeline girls pointed out that there are no street lights around Bandra terminus due to which they face difficulties.
- Watched 5 movies as a part of the training session on violence against women at YMCA in September.
- Information on Sec 498A, Dowry Death, Section 304 & rape cases was given by Pouri & Gauri in September. They conducted a training of trainers (TOT) for 2 days at YMCA on Gender & Law.
- In October a safety walk was done from Colgate Ground to skywalk in Bandra east in which 10 girls participated. The purpose of the walk was to assess how safe public places are for young women.
- A visit was made in October along with 7 girls to Mahila Vikas Kendra in order to understand the issues of working women especially those working in the unorganised sector.
- As part of the Training of Trainers programme Iram who is a Sehr trainer took a session on Gender with 11 girls in Navpada in October.
- On 31st October full day training was held on Leadership in Chota Kashmir. 14 girls undertook the training.
- A session on the Muslim Personal Law was conducted in November. 6 girls attended the session.
- A football match was organised by Sehr at Colgate Maidan in November.
- The girls also attended play organised by Mohalla Committee Movement Trust on peace & Harmony in November.
- Training on leadership was conducted at the Karnala Bird sanctuary in November. 6 girls from Sehr Navpada participated.

- 7 girls from SEHR group participated in a rally on 15th November 2014.
 - Rallies conducted by the Sehr group on issues like Dalit Muslims, recent Peshawar attack.
- A basic Gender session was conducted on 6th November 2014 with 20 girls by Dr. Noorjehan Safia Niaz.
- A TOT was conducted by Suraiya as the resource person with 11 girls in November.
- The girls were made to visit the family court, police station, Mantralaya, National Science Centre and the Planetarium.
- The Sehr groups also took part in a press conference.
- Sehr girls undertook training in self-defense.
- 5 girls took admission for 12th in Yashwantrao University in February.
- 3 boys and 4 girls took admission in YCMOU for 12th class in March.
- 32 girls and 21 women from unorganised sector opened accounts in Central Bank of India in March.
- 3 girls made voter id's and 5 girls made PAN cards in March.
- A visit was made to the R.D. National College (Bandra) in June for collecting information about the YCMOU scheme on education for people over 18 years. A list of names was prepared for YCMOU from Kalina – 20, Bharat Nagar – 15, Navpada-15.
- Suraiya gathered information on Interior Designing certificate course and girls hostel in Pune in July.
- Aliya visited YCMOU twice once to enquire about admission and the second visit was for the admission of 8 girls in the month of July.
- Went to Dadar for morcha organized by BMMA against Peshawar attack.
- 2 TOT have been done with 3 new girls & 3 old ones in December.
- 7 girls made their area map in December.
- Basic Gender meeting with 14 girls.

BMMA-UDAAN

- Monthly meetings were conducted regularly.
 - In January a meeting was conducted with the parents and a movie was screened in which the Udaan boys participated.
 - 2 meetings were held with boys in February. In one meeting English speaking was practiced and in another a film on importance of law was screened.
 - A new group with 25 boys was formed and a meeting was conducted in April.

- 2 meetings were conducted in the community by Arpan on sexual abuse in May.
 - Young boys and girls were consulted for planning the budget. 25 Girls and 16 boys attended this meeting in July.
 - Children of Bharat Nagar were visited in August.
 - 4-5 families of young boys in Navpada and Pipeline were visited and were invited to a meeting in September.
 - 5 Weekly meetings of Udaan group held in December attended by children of Navpada and pipeline along with MAVA.
- Programmes on working with children in the communities were worked out with Pratham in January.
 - A play was performed by the Udaan group on the 20th year celebration of CSSS in February. The theme of the play was secularism and communal harmony.
 - Little BMMA was launched on 22nd February to prepare children as leaders.
 - This group consists of young girls and boys who will be trained to be leaders.
 - In this meeting the group discussed the various problems they face in the community. They categorised them as problems related to health, education, infrastructure, safety of girls, job opportunities and attitude of the police
 - The group was also given information about the upcoming elections and the roles and responsibilities of our elected representatives.
 - 18 boys visited the City Park for planning and sharing difficulties faced in forming groups in February.
 - In February 20 boys visited the Traffic Controller office in Churchgate. They got information about traffic rules, silence zones, understanding sign boards etc.
 - Two meetings of Little BMMA were held in March. During the first meeting issues for election were discussed and in the second meeting coordination between Udaan and Sehr were discussed. The significance of Little BMMA was explained to everyone.
 - A health talk was conducted for 18 young children by Dr. Gokhale on 2nd March. She spoke on good eating habits and the ill effects of smoking, drinking and drugs.
 - An Open Mic session was held on 16th March at CSSS organized by Kabeera. 8 boys participated. Sufian was awarded a prize for the best performance.
 - 8 girls and 1 boy participated in a dance performance at Kalsa College in March. It was a huge success and was even written about in Mid-day.
 - In April children presented their problems which they face in the family and community in Bal Parishad.
 - Boys along with girls attended training workshop on 'Dreams and Aspirations' in May.
 - 23 boys attended a career guidance session on the pharmaceutical industry conducted by Shriharsh Kaushik in May and 4 boys attended a theatre workshop conducted by Ravi Pednekar.

- In May, a boy from Mahim secured a job in Reliance through the Kotak Group.
- A Cricket Tournament was organised on 7th Jun'14 between the boys of Navpada, Bharat nagar and Kalina. There were two groups of 12 boys from each area one between the age of 8-13yrs and 14-20yrs. Lots were drawn and both the teams of Kalina were lucky as they had a chance to play directly in the final. Bharat Nagar team won the winner's trophy in both the age group followed by Kalina as the runners-up.
- 25 tickets were sponsored for Sehr and Udaan group members by Jackie Shroff for his son's movie Heropanti on 8th Jun'14.
- Bharat Nagar youth attended the vocational training program held on 19th Jun'14.
- The Community news letter was prepared and sent to Action aid in June.
- Parents of 15 children were visited and spoken to regarding a 3 day camp organised by MAVA on gender equality. 9 boys attended this camp in August.
- MAVA held a meeting with the Udaan group of Navpada and Pipeline in September. The meeting was attended by 5-9 young boys. The session included games, recitation, activities and discussion on gender.
- Sindhu Jogi from Magic Bus was spoken to in September to understand and collaborate to help overall growth of the children.
- An Open Mic session was held on 5th October at CSSS office. 4 children from Udaan group participated and were awarded a prize for their performance.
- Mind Frame organisation was visited in October with the aim of understanding their work with children.
- In October a 3 day English speaking course was conducted for the children. 8-10 children from Udaan group attended the training.
- 13 children attended a two day workshop on 31st Oct and 1st Nov organised in collaboration with MAVA on violence and gender. Games were played to further the cause of peace.
- Celebrated children's day with Udaan & Kabeera group on 14th November'14. The total strength of children was 26 of which 12 & 14 were from Udaan & kabeera respectively. Children volunteered to contribute Rs.300/- for jersey with BMMA logo and name. They will practice games for Peace learned in the camp for the next 1-2 month and organise games for the children for Navpada community in January 2015.
- In November a news Reporter interviewed children about their opinion on Whatsapp and other technology and the impact it has on their day to day activities.
- 21 forms were filled in February for opening zero-balance accounts in Central Bank.
- The Youth survey form was finalized. The work started in March from Bharat Nagar and 18 forms (approx.) were filled.
- In March, 2 children were identified and verified for the CSSS sponsorship. (Sherin who lost her father last year and Soha is the daughter of our area leader.)
- Activities & games organized by magic bus with LRP children.
- Gender training through different games with Udaan & MAVA was conducted in December.

- Video film was made with MAVA & Udaan group.

UDAAN JUNIOR

- Funding material was prepared for children in October.
- A PAN card camp was held for the parents of Udaan Junior in October.
- Coordination with Magic Bus and 2 meetings were conducted for planning with parents in October. 22 parents attended the meeting.
- Fire Brigade at Bandra (w) and Nehru Science Centre – Worli on 21st Oct'14 were visited by 58 children and 16 volunteers In October.
- Sports day was organised on 30th Oct at Navpada .80 children participated in at least one game each of the three games organised. Spoon and marble, Potato Race and finding the Gem were the three games organized.
- 27 children from Bharat Nagar attended a sports activity conducted by Magic Bus volunteers on 30th Nov'2014.

- The Muslim Law Survey was coordinated with Mr. Shinde and Mr. Kale in January and February.
- The syllabus for Qaziat was prepared in February and syllabus books were bought.
- The draft was worked on with Adv. Gayatri in March and April.
- Adv. Ranka Arya and other NC members in Bhopal were consulted in March for suggestions.
- The MPL survey data was refined and coordinated with Lia for data finalization in March.
- The MPL survey was finalized and forwarded in April.
- BMMA released the "Muslim Personal Draft" on 18th Jun'14 at Marathi Patrakar Shang .
 - The meeting was attended by 58 people. The participants constituted of national council members, core team members, few area leaders with their team members and the press.
 - The need for the change in the Muslim Personal Law stems from the fact that there is a well-defined marriage law in place for all other religions except

Muslims. This results in the Shariat being interpreted according to one's own convenience eventually culminating into injustice for women.

- Lawyers, religious leaders, educational teachers, doctorates etc. were consulted from all over India. The survey was conducted in 10 states and 4710 women were interviewed from various parts of India on the current status of Muslim women and the draft brings together these inputs.
- This draft brings clarity on the age of marriage, the mehr amount, the procedure to avail a divorce, ban or oral divorce / triple talak, restriction on polygamy, adoption, custody of the child etc. These are all derived from the Quran.
- A Press conference was held to release the codified draft in Pune on 8th Aug'14.
- On 15 August a program was organised for the solved cases from 2010 till date of which 45 women attended the program and shared their experiences.
- Training on the BMMA's Marriage and Divorce Act was conducted with the members of the Aurton ki Shariat Adalat in October.
- Press conferences in other states

- Forms were taken from MAFC for education and personal loan in February. Loan forms were given out to 10 people.
- 100 forms for hawker's license were distributed in Navapda, Bharatnagar, Behrampada, Kalina and Mahim in February.
